

- 5 mixes in 6 monitors, side fills when possible.
- We provide instruments mics, clamps, zbars and backline (all that is written in BOLD) No sharing with support band. 2 tall straight stand with round base and a tall + boom stand are needed.

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I will also need:

- 2 Stereo groups with stereo compression on it.
- 1 Delay Unit (TC Electronic D-Two)
- 1 Reverb Unit (TC Electronic M5000/2000 / 2 engines)
- 1 Stereo Graphic Eq for FOH.

If monitors are done from the FOH, 1 Graphic Eq for each monitor.

Notes (important)

- I'm an easy guy, I don't complain a lot when everything works fine. I LOVE analogue mixing desk. I always prefer those ones: H3000/XL3/XL4 or MH3/4. Anyway, Soundcraft Vi series/Yamaha CL5/Midas Pro series are fine with me (except if you have a nice analogue desk).
- I try to work fast and good, feel free to send me your tech rider, dBs limit instructions or any usefull info.
- Ty Segall & The Freedom Band is a **VERY LOUD** band. Average spl on stage is about 110dBs.
- Don't even ask about using a drum riser. Thank you.
- NO STAGE BARRIERS PLEASE when possible.
